### Call for participants in an Erasmus+ Programme

#### Are you interested in:

- Working with international teams and meeting students and volunteers from abroad?

The aim of the project is to contribute to innovation in the area of sport studies and development studies. #### What is the plan?

- The fieldtrip will run from **19<sup>th</sup> September until 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022** and take place at **University of Brighton (UK)** – this will include visits to sport for development projects, and meeting leaders in the field.
- The course will include attendance at the **Football 4 Peace Training Camp** where you would engage in coaching and development workshops designed to build communities.
- The fieldtrip will provide the opportunity to work with students from our partner institutions.



#### Who can participate?

Bachelor and master students from the Universities of Brighton, Palacky (sport and development studies), and Paderborn.

#### How much will it cost? Do I get credits?

All accommodation, flights and some spending money are provided. You get 6 credits for **MRS/SFD** or **KSK/@SFD**.
